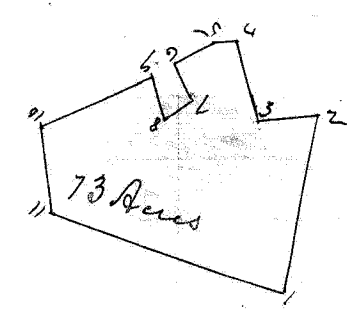

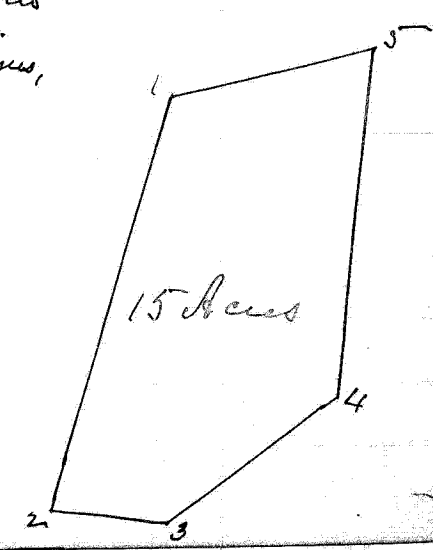

Agreable to an order from the Court of Rockingham dated August Court 1815 to us the Subscribers directed for the purpose of assigning unto Widow Barbara Harnsberger late wife of Conrad Harnsberger deceased her right of Dowry in her ^{1st} Husband Land we have proceeded to lay and assign her right of Dowry in Three separate parcels of Land. The first of which parcels of Land assigned her containing Seventy three acres being a part of the tract of Land whereon she now lives and Bounded as follows Beginning at a white oak corner to Stephen Cournoys Land and running with a line of said Cournoys S 20 W 93 poles to a stake. Thence South 84 E 33 poles to a stake by a meadow thence across the meadow on S 3 E 42 poles to a Lane and with the said Lane S 86 E 10 poles to another stake. Thence N 76 E 23 poles to a stone on the hill in the front of two Dwelling Houses. Thence passing between the 5th Houses N 17 E W 21 poles to near a Gran Yard. Thence N 63 E 16 poles to a stake on the North East End of a Barn. Thence S 11 E 24 poles to a stone in a Lane and with Sth Lane N 70 E 70 poles to a stone on the side of a road. Thence N 3 E W 52 poles to a double white oak on Millers line and with said line N 67 W 127 Poles to the Beginning.



The second tract containing seventeen acres which we cut off of the west of a 342 acre survey and Bounded as follows. Beginning at a white oak on a line of 1st tract and running S 10 E 32 poles to a stake near the road. Thence running nearly with the road N 77 E 68 poles to a hickory on Road with Sth Road S 82 E 23 poles to a white oak and hickory on side of the Sth Road. Thence N 10 W 29 poles to the line of Sth 342 acre tract and with the same N 88 W 100 poles to the Beginning. The third tract containing 150 acres and being also a part of the 342 acre tract and the east end thereof Bounded as follows. Beginning at two pines corner to Stephen Cournoys land and with his line S 42 E 229 poles to two pines. Thence N 33 E 60 poles to two pines. Thence N 4 W 100 poles to two pines. Thence N 50 W 186 poles to a pine. Thence across the tract S 20 W 110 poles to the Beginning. We further assign the Sth Widow the one third of the Marshall Mill. The one third of the Saw Mill. The one third of the Cotton Machine and Tilt Hammer together with privilege of drawing a part of the water from the mill Tobay and to convey it to her meadow whenever



The 1st Mill and other Machinery can spare it. but whenever the whole of the water to the Mill and other Machinery aforesaid it must be used by them. We also assign unto the 1st Widow the privilege of passing & repassing to the well and using the water thereof which 1st Well is upon the lands belonging to the Legatees. And further we are of opinion that the Land between the Dwelling Houses and mill Race and including 1st Race from the Mill Hobay unto four poles above the Saw Mill should be kept open for the benefit of both the Widows & Legatees as a watering place for their Stock. And lastly we assign unto the 1st Widow that part of the Apple Orchard lying in a triangle next to the Cotton Machine including Mountain Trees as Marked off the Marked Trees to be included in her part

This Indenture made the Twenty seventh day of June in -- Year 1815 Between John Graham and Margant his wife of the -- of Rockingham and State of Virginia of the one part and George Harrison of the County and State aforesaid of the other part -- -- sth That the said John Graham and Margant Graham his wife -- -- consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and fifty -- -- sold and by These do grant bargain and sell to the -- Geo. W. Harrison and his heirs and assigns a certain Lot or parcel of Land Wherein there are two dwelling Houses situate lying and being in the Town of Harrisonburg in the said County of Rockingham known and designated on the first plat of said Town by No 12 adjoining to and on the North Side of the Publick Square but on the present plat of said Town it is Marked No 9 on the Northern Side of the said Square which said Lot is bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a stake on the north side of the Publick Lot corner to Tutwiler's Lot and running Thence along the W side of the Alley as properly laid off North Thirteen Degrees East ten poles to Elizabeth Street at said Tutwiler's corner and with Elizabeth Street South Eighty Degrees East Sixty Three feet and as much farther as to reach the corner of Charles McLeans Lot at present owned by the heirs of Hugh Donaghe Thence with the line of the same and Oullivans line South ten degrees West ten poles to the publick Square and with the same North Eighty Degrees West Seventy feet to the Beginning.
